## The Rescue Report

It is time for those pesky numbers again – the annual statistics. Every year we feel that we worked harder that year than the previous year but the numbers do not always support that feeling - that is, until you look at them closely and break down the various categories. In 2010, we actually accepted 13 dogs fewer than in 2009 despite the fact that we started the year off with a sudden intake of 10 dogs. We did see the trend of taking in more dogs with medical problems continue with an increase in vet expenses of approximately \$1100. We funded 2 TPLO surgeries, Cherry Eye surgery, several tumor/lump removal surgeries and ended the year with an urgent intake that required surgery for bowel obstruction. That dog, Graham, is now in his forever home. We funded diagnosis and care of 3 dogs with seizure issues. Total vet expenses for 2010 were \$27,854.29. Rescue is an expensive business.



Of the 56 dogs that came to Rescue, 34 were males and 22 were females. This 60-40 ratio is what we historically see and last year's 50-50 split was unusual. Age breakdown was: 23 dogs 0-2 years old; 16 dogs 3-5 years old; 9 dogs 6-8 years old; 6 dogs 9-11 years old and 2 dogs 12yr or older. Only 15 of these dogs came from shelters with the rest from owners; 38 or 68% were already altered when we took them. We refused to take 8 dogs based on temperament. Fortunately, we did not have to euthanize any due to temperament but had to send two dogs to the bridge due to health problems after they had spent weeks in hospice care. Another senior passed away during the night while in foster care.



So why do we feel like we have worked very hard even though the intake numbers are down. There is the obvious reason that more dogs requiring surgery or more extensive medical care which means a longer and more labor intensive stay in foster care and more trips to vets and specialists. What is not so obvious until you look at our statistics is the fact that of the 56 dogs taken in, 53 were fostered (95%) with only 3 dogs being placed directly from their home. This percentage has steadily increased over the years with it being 87% in 2009 which was increase compared to the previous year. Fostering the dogs gives us much more information as to their behavior and personality which helps us in determining the best placement for them so we prefer to do it whenever possible.

We found the trend of senior dogs continued in January 2011. We were asked to take Gus and Max, initially thought to be 8 yr old but vet records showed they were more likely 10 yrs old. They were left in the backyard

when their owner died and fed by the neighbors for a year! When the executor of the estate deemed they should be euthanized, a Good Samaritan who was at the house doing roof work, offered to take them. He had them for a month and then contacted us. Gus is purebred and Max is a mix but they are both incredibly sweet dogs and bonded at the hip. Sue and Rich Randall fostered them including getting them to several vet appointments. After posting them on our website, a lovely couple who missed their old Golden expressed an interest in fostering and possibly adopting them. Sue and Rich delivered Gus and Max to these folks in Pt. Townsend doing a home check at the same time. It was just a matter of days before they decided that they were totally in love with both dogs and the arrangement would be permanent! We are absolutely overjoyed that we could keep these guys together. A bit of a miracle – just the first of many that I hope we see in 2011.

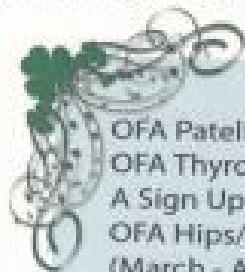
