To be awarded to any dog earning an MX or MXJ or MXP or MJP in AKC Agility

Conformation Trophies

AM/CAN CH BECKWITH'S EARLY ECLIPSE SDHF - Top Show Dog Trophy – donated by Janet Trask

Presented to the owner of the dog earning the most points by the scale below at AKC shows

AM/CAN CH BECKWITH'S CHIANTI AM/CAN CDX, CAN WC – Top Show Bitch Trophy – donated by Ludell Beckwith

Presented to the owner of the bitch earning the most points by the scale below at AKC shows

A dog or bitch awarded Best in Show or Best of Breed at the GRCA National Specialty will automatically win the award. Otherwise, points will be calculated from the following scale:

AM/CAN CH BECKWITH'S CHIVAS REGAL – Show Puppy of the Year – donated by Alan and Pam Sage

Awarded to the owner in recognition of the puppy who defeats the most dogs in AKC regular classes before its first birthday

AM/CAN CH SWEETGOLD'S WINNERS CIRCLE – Breeder/Owner/Handler Trophy – donated by Richard and Kim Anton

This trophy will be awarded to honor the dedication and outstanding achievement of Breeders who solely handle their own dogs to an AKC Championship title. By actively participating in Conformation competition, a Breeder gains a higher understanding of breed type, structure and movement as it relates to the AKC Golden Retriever Breed Standard; which translates to building a stronger breeding program. As the sole handler, the Breeder more fully appreciates the importance of training, conditioning, preparation, and presentation.

An EGRC Full Member who has fulfilled the Club's trophy eligibility requirements may apply for this trophy in the year an AKC CH title has been earned provided: he/she is the Breeder and Owner of a Golden Retriever which he/she has handled in all shows where Championship points have been earned. In the case of dogs Co-owned and/or Co-bred by non-members (or ineligible members), only the award applicant who is the actual handler of the dog must be an EGRC Full Member meeting the eligibility requirements.

Points may be accumulated in previous years, however the EGRC trophy eligibility requirements need only be met by the EGRC Full Member/Breeder/Handler(s) in the year the Championship title is achieved.

This non-competitive “challenge trophy” may be awarded to multiple eligible EGRC members in the same year. In the event of multiple recipients, the names of each Breeder/Owner/Handler(s) and their dog will be engraved in chronological order of Championship Title achievement. Possession of the trophy will be shared equally between all recipients: for that year.

This trophy can only be awarded once per dog. However, there is no limit to the number of times an eligible EGRC member can earn the trophy with various dogs qualifying in the same year.

Since each EAGRC member has multiple opportunities to receive this non-competitive award each year, it is intended that this trophy will remain in circulation and will not be eligible for retirement after three awards to the same recipient.

AM/CAN/BER/MEX/COL CH BECKWITHS COPPER COIN – Amateur Challenge Trophy – Donated by Mr. and Mrs. R.E. Beckwith

This award is to acknowledge the Amateur Handler of a Golden (dog or bitch) that defeats the most dogs in AKC Licensed competition. The only wins counted will be those at the hands of the amateur owner/handler/member.

An Amateur is anyone who engages in a pursuit for pleasure and never for money or one who isn’t an expert in conformation handling. One who has earned this award before is not eligible because by virtue of experience gained has risen to “more than amateur status”

Field Trophies

BRACKENHOLLOW STONEY BROKE MEMORIAL TROPHY - High Point Derby Dog – donated by Sheila Fowler Ward

This award is presented to the member who accumulates the most points running his or her dog in the Derby Class. Licensed Placements and JAM’s will take precedence over Picnic placements. Use Derby column in the following award (Amateur Field Trial Handler) scale to determine points.

BRACKENHOLLOW MARCHER COLA - Amateur Field Trial Handler Trophy – donated by Sheila Fowler Ward

Presented to the member who accumulates the most points by the scale below, as an amateur handler at Picnic, AKC Sanctioned, or AKC Licensed Retriever Trials.

BRAKENHOLLOW TOUCH OF GOLD AM/CAN WCX SH – Advanced Hunting Retriever Trophy – donated by Sue Anderson

Presented to the member whose dog accumulates the most points by the scale below at Licensed AKC, CKC, UKC, or NAHRA Sanctioned Hunt Tests or GRCA or CKC WC/WCI/WCX tests. Each dog is considered separately. The dog is to be handled by an amateur handler.

Obedience Trophies

DAVIS NOVICE CUP – donated by Charlotte Davis

Presented to the Novice handler/owner (anyone who has never put an obedience title on a dog before) for the highest scoring dog from the Novice Class. Only the first three (3) qualifying legs will count and will be combined to determine the winner. The purpose of this trophy is to recognize and encourage the beginning trainer. It can never be awarded to the same person twice.

AM/CAN OTCH BRANDYS GOLDEN NICOLE AM/CAN TD WC – Top Novice Dog – donated by Sharon Colvin

Awarded to recognize the dog with the highest total three (3) scores in AKC Novice Obedience during the year. The dog must be owned or co-owned, trained, and exhibited by an EGRC member.

AM/CAN OTCH BECKWITH'S HENNESSY FIVE STAR AM/CAN TDX – Top Open Dog – donated by Nancy Light

Awarded to recognize the dog with the highest total 3 scores in AKC Open Obedience during the year. The dog must be owned or co-owned, trained, and exhibited by an EGRC member

AM/CAN OTCH EASTGATE'S GOLDEN TRISH – Top Utility Dog – donated by Bill and Jeanette Bedingfield

Awarded to recognize the dog with the highest total 3 scores in AKC Utility Obedience during the year. The dog must be owned or co-owned, trained, and exhibited by an EGRC member

AM/CAN CH BECKWITH'S MALAGOLD FLASH AM/CAN UDT WC – Perpetual Obedience Trophy – donated by Carol Kvamme

Awarded to recognize the dog with the highest total 3 scores in obedience during the year from any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility class. The dog must be owned or co-owned, trained, and exhibited by and EGRC member

Multipurpose Trophies

SUNNTACH'S SWEET TENACITY AM UDTX WCX SD, CAN CDX WCX TD – Hunting Retriever/Obedience Dual Purpose Dog – donated by Bob Fetty

This award is to recognize the dogs that have earned titles in both field and obedience. The applicant's dog must have been awarded at least one title in the award year. Any member may apply in a given year however the dogs which have not received the award previously shall be given preference. Applicants may add only the points (from the scale below) obtained from the highest title received in each discipline (i.e. field or obedience) regardless of the registry.

May be awarded to a dog more than one time provided the dog has achieved a new title during the year the award is being applied for. Preference will be given to a dog who has never won the award.

The dog must earn 35 or more points according to the following point schedule.

This trophy may be awarded more than once to a dog as long as that dog adds a new title or points to their previous total during the year the award is being applied for. In other words, it is still actively competing (i.e. another JAM, Lic. Placement or WCX or a Champion taking BOS or better). **Only the highest point value in each area can be counted.**

ROBERTA ANDERSON AWARDS

Three new EGRC Awards have been created from the GRCA Plaques earned by ROBERTA ANDERSON in 1970 and 1971. They are to recognize dogs with high Obedience scores who also compete in other venues.

1. The Roberta Anderson award recognizing the Golden Retriever with a Field Title that has earned the highest AKC, CKC, or UKC OBEDIENCE SCORE for the year. The field title can be from AKC, CKC, or UKC Hunt Tests, Field Trials, or GRCA recognized Working Certificate events. Such field titles need not be earned in the year for which the member applies.
2. The Roberta Anderson award recognizing the Golden Retriever with a Tracking Title that has earned the highest AKC, CKC, or UKC OBEDIENCE SCORE for the year. The tracking title can be earned previously from any level of AKC or CKC tests.
3. The Roberta Anderson award recognizing the Golden Retriever with AKC or CKC Conformation Points or CCA, that has earned the highest AKC, CKC, or UKC OBEDIENCE SCORE for the year. The conformation points or CCA do not have to be earned in the same year.

Miscellaneous Trophies

WR U-UD SUNNTACH'S C'ESTSI BON UDTX SH AM/CANWCX CANUDT JH TROPHY – donated by Joan Fetty

Awarded to the oldest dog to earn a title each year. The title can be earned from any verifiable recognized organization. The basis for awarding the trophy is the dog's age on the date the new title is earned.

ORYAN GOLDENS TROPHY – donated by Caroline McCormick

To honor the dog earning the most titles during the year from any verifiable recognizable organization. It does not include TT (Temperament Test) or CGC (Canine Good Citizen).

WILSON AWARD

Awarded to the owner of any Rescue Golden who earns a title in any of the following areas during the calendar year – Obedience, Rally, Field, Tracking, or Agility.

Tracking Trophy

CORR VON ROUGE AM CDX TDX, CAN CD TDX – donated by Joan Fetty

Recognizing all Golden Retrievers earning a TDX. To be awarded to a dog that earns an American or Canadian TDX degree. To be shared equally between dogs if there is more than one dog.

Junior Trophies

EGRC JUNIOR CONFORMATION HANDLER

Awarded to the Junior handler/member who defeats the most Junior Handlers in AKC Junior Showmanship during the year.

EGRC JUNIOR OBEDIENCE TROPHY

Awarded to the Junior handle/member who accumulates the most points according to the following scale.

EGRC MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD TROPHY — donated by EGRC

EGRC members may submit to any Board member by January 31st a written nomination for the Club's Member of the Year Award. When nominating someone you should consider their service to the club, general attitude and conduct, and personal achievement. Nominations shall include the name and also the reason(s) for the nomination. At the February Board meeting each year, in executive session only, the President will appoint the Board Members present as a committee to elect the recipient by secret ballot (ties to be broken by the President) with the President tallying the results and confidentially giving the name plus the ballots to the Awards Chairman who will then have the trophy engraved, masked, and presented at the Awards meeting for presentation by the President.
